SUNDAY/SATURDAY

2. What makes a rescue daring or miraculous?
3. Can someone explain what God's rescue plan is?
4. What is significant about God's rescue plan?
5. What type of love does Jesus have for us? (He displayed this love on the cross)
6. Have you experienced God's rescue plan?

SUNDAY/MONDAY

1. Can someone explain and/or give an example of what a false "support wall" would be in our lives? (Intellect, athletic ability, popularity, family name, etc.)
2. How did God use Rahab and why is that significant?
3. Someone explain Proverbs 3:5-6 in your own words.
4. Is it hard for you to fully trust God? Why?
5. What would be some examples of unlikely candidates in God's rescue in our world today?

MONDAY

1. Have you ever had to go to a plan B or C (family vacation, sports, plans with friends, school assignments)?
2. Have you ever witnessed a true miracle of God?

Read Exodus 14:21-31

3. What do you think were some of the thoughts of the Israelites in that moment?
4. Would you have been thinking the same way?
5. What does this rescue by God teach about why we need to trust Him?
6. Is God able to do miraculous things in our lives?
7. How should the truth that God is able to do miracles in our lives, affect the way we live each day?

TUESDAY

1. Did God show or reveal anything to you tonight?
2. Why is prayer so important?
3. What was God leading you to pray for tonight? Why?
4. We know God's rescue is for all people, are there people in your life that need God's rescue?
5. Will you allow God to use you to tell them how to be rescued by God?
6. What is the biggest thing you will take away from tonight's concert of prayer?

THURSDAY

1. What are you most scared of?
2. What are you most scared of when it comes to living out your faith and telling people about Jesus?
3. Can you relate to Jonah (running away from what God is calling you to do)?
4. Why will God sometimes allow us to be "eaten by our circumstances" to get our attention?
5. Is God calling you to do something that you're running from?
6. Why is it so important for us to say yes to God's calling and follow Him?

3. Why do you think we still choose to not follow God sometimes?
